ProAiir™ Ink

ProAiir™ Ink temporary airbrush tattoo ink is designed for applications that require speedy results. Our Ink does not require powder between layers although it is recommended on the final layer to achieve maximum durability. **ProAiir™** Ink is waterproof and will last from 7 to 14 days depending on placement and can be removed with alcohol or baby oil.

THIS PRODUCT IS NOT FOR FACE PAINTING!

Directions for use:

- Set air pressure between 20-30 PSI (may vary by compressor / humidity - keep it comfortable)
- Shake makeup bottle before securing to airbrush with adaptor caps
- Use with adequate ventilation, keeping away from flames
- Best when applied to clean, oil-free skin. Wipe skin with rubbing alcohol first is best.
- Lightly hold stencil against skin, if applicable. Add layers for visual interest. Mix colors to make other colors.
- Spray between 2-4 inches from skin for best color and control.
- Apply in light coats, layering for deeper effect. Too much will cause stickiness. Apply powder if that happens.
- Wipe off overspray with rubbing alcohol.
- Optional - lightly dust with baby, talc, makeup translucent powders using makeup brush.
- Avoid ink clumps caused by moisture getting into makeup bottles on high humidity days - place **INLINE DESICCANT** filter after water trap to filter all water. ProAiir hates water!

Tip: When using metallic inks, spray a little heavier coverage than normal and don't use powder. Powder would obscure the metallic effect. Hairspray can be added to extend the life of tattoo designs!

Removal from skin:

- Remember that **ProAiir™** is waterproof! Water will NOT work.
- Wipe off with rubbing alcohol or baby oil. Tattoo will fade over time with the natural oils of skin.

TIPS

- To remove from fabric: Do NOT use water. Apply alcohol and saturate.
- Adding a marble or stainless steel nut to the bottle can help with mixing liquids.
- Glass bottles are NOT recommended. Use plastic instead. Glass may break and it attracts heat, causing evaporation of product or thickening.

Airbrush cleaning:

- Use 91%+ rubbing alcohol or denatured alcohol for extensive cleaning.
- Spray Denatured Alcohol through airbrush (front spray and back flush). Seek out the biodegradable green formula found at Home Depot or Lowes paint dept.). Isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol) is not recommended as it contains water and may gum up your airbrush.
- For storage, withdraw airbrush needle slightly, tighten in place then place airbrush tip down into storage jar containing roughly one inch of Denatured Alcohol. (just enough to submerge the airbrush siphon)
- Storing airbrushes in Denatured Alcohol will prevent makeup from drying inside airbrushes until you get home and have time to clean them thoroughly. Done.

Stencil cleaning:

- When stencils require cleaning to restore appearance, store in zip-locking bag or shallow bowl containing Denatured Alcohol or 91%+ Rubbing Alcohol for 30-60 minutes. Rinse and dry upon removing.
- For stencils "caked" with makeup, scrub with bristle brush when removing with Alcohol.
- For really "gunked up" stencils, place in sonic cleaner with Alcohol, scrub with bristle brush if necessary, then rinse and dry upon removing.
- Stencils with adhesives use Goo Gone or turpentine in a container and let soak for 60 minutes.
- After stencil is clean, rinse with water or place flat on paper towel.

- Not recommended for the Vinyl tattoo stencil books. Stencils may STICK to pages and rip upon removal. Powder or layer with wax paper.

Special notes:

- **ProAiir™** Ink colors CAN be mixed with other **ProAiir™** Ink colors to create new blended colors.
- Do NOT mix ProAiir™ with water or any other Ink product.
- Fluorescent colors may separate and require mixing or stirring. We'll fix that soon!
- Should separation occur, shake, stir or quickly back flush the airbrush (cover the adaptor cap air hole a spray briefly to mix pigments).
- If applied too thick, INK will take longer to dry and may be sticky to the touch. Less is best!
- If using StencilBooks, you may wish to apply powder to stencil after use or use wax paper in between pages to prevent sticking.
- Metallic colors generally have shorter staying power than other formulas.
- Do not apply to open wounds or soars.
- Glass bottles are NOT recommended. Use plastic instead. Glass may break and it attracts heat, causing evaporation of product or thickening.
